

THE STORY (spoiler alert)


Main character:

Prudence: a 15-year-old orphan who has the particularity to see into the future in her dreams. When the story starts, she lives as an outcast at the outskirts of a village and she survives by doing some healer work, thanks to her medical knowledge. She is thin and small for her age, but resourceful and independent.

Event: During the autumn festival, the pirates from the sky, coming from the High World, attack Prudence's village to steal a relic. The previous doctor aboard being dead, they kidnap her because of her healer skills. She wakes up on the ship called *The Heliotrope*, floating in the sky, and from now on, prisoner. Little by little, she gets used to her new life and acquaints herself with the place and the crew, especially: Ezekiel (the captain's aide de camp, with a lively mind and an acute sense of strategy), Sergeï (head chef and steward, frightening at first but actually friendly and welcoming), Petrus (the captain's first lieutenant, a gigantic man with bad temper and impressive muscles), Gareth (the on-board helmsman and astronomer, with mechanical arms and

legs), Captain Theodore Mousquet (mysterious and unpredictable, feared by his enemies and respected by his crew). One day, Prudence foresees an attack on the ship, thus, protecting the crew. The Captain reveals to her that they are looking for the place where the Alchemists might have hidden their fabulous treasure. The pirates already found one key, and they are looking for other clues to guide them to the location.

Outcome: The Heliotrope's crew, of which Prudence is a part of, travels across the world from one clue to the other. During their quest, they suffer from the persistent hunt of the Royal Fleet and the vindictive attacks of the mob: the Reverse-Winds. Their peregrinations will bring them one by one to various places: the wild islands, a den of robbers, a ball in Port-Regal, the arctic islands, under the sea surface and, eventually, underground. Prudence realizes the extent of her powers as they are getting closer to the Impossible City and as she becomes friends with her kidnappers. The story ends with the discovery of the city, where Prudence suddenly remembers she already came here, a long time ago.



VOLUME 2: THE ALCHEMISTS

The Heliotrope's crew finally reach the gate of the Impossible City, leaving Prudence with a strange feeling of $d\acute{e}j\grave{a}$ -vu. In addition to the immeasurable treasure that is waiting for them there, they also discover a intriguing sarcophagus ... But the pirates' curiosity faces some stiff consequences: the arrival of a young girl has been predicted and Prudence triggers a tragic prophecy. Seized by the visions of an imminent curse, her soul wanders between two worlds! But she is the only one who could prevent the prophecy from happening...with some help. To wake her up and avoid the disaster, the pirates don't have any other choice than to take on a new mission: find the last traces of the heirs of the alchemists...
